


• Take a Tour!

Not For the Faint At Heart

It was the night of Oct. 1st 1993 in Petaluma, Ca. Polly Klaas, Marc's daughter was having a slumber party at home. She had invited her two best friends Kate McLean and Gillian Pelham over for a night of fun. All three attended Petaluma Junior High and all three even played the same musical instrument – the clarinet. The girls were playing a board game and afterwards Polly decided to gather up some sleeping bags from the living room. Later, witnesses described a man with gray bushy hair and thickly built, outside the

home, but thought he might be a vagrant or somebody out for a walk. As it turned out, that was not. The antagonist was the infamous killer Richard Allen Davis, a smug and heartless child predator that entered the home of Eve Nichol, (Polly's mother) who was asleep as the girls played. As the girls stepped out from her bedroom, Polly was surprised by a man whom she didn't recognize. He had a knife and held it to her throat. He immediately ordered them not to scream or he'd cut their throats. The three remained quiet until he asked them who lived there. Polly replied, "I do." When the incident first occurred, her friends thought it was a practical joke – with Halloween nearing. The man refused \$50 that Polly offered him and told the three girls to lie down on the floor. He then tied their hands behind their backs and covered their heads with hoods. Polly begged the stranger not to harm her mother and sister who were asleep in the home. He kept reassuring them that he wasn't going to hurt them and that he was just doing

it for the money. He then picked up Polly, and told the girls to count to 1000 – he then left with Polly. That was the last time she was seen alive –except by the killer. By 10:45 P.M. Eve Nichol was told about the horrific encounter. She immediately called 911. Polly Klaas' body was found nine weeks later on December 3rd 1993. She had been raped and murdered. The perpetrator. Richard Allen Davis was later captured and convicted of murder. He is currently on death row at San Quinton Prison in California. All appeals by Davis have been denied.



Gold Nugget Days celebrates finding a 54-pound gold nugget in 1859. The celebration began in 1959 and has continued every year since. The celebration of the discovery of the Dogtown nugget runs from April 26th through April 29th


